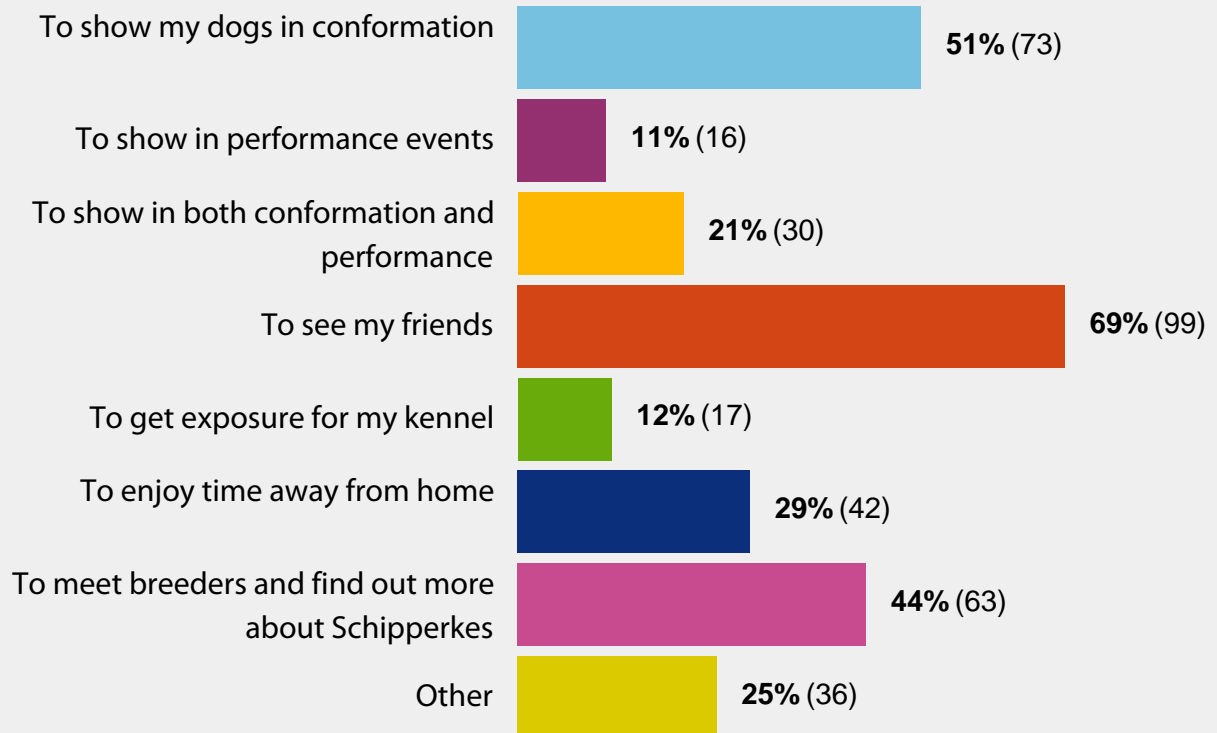
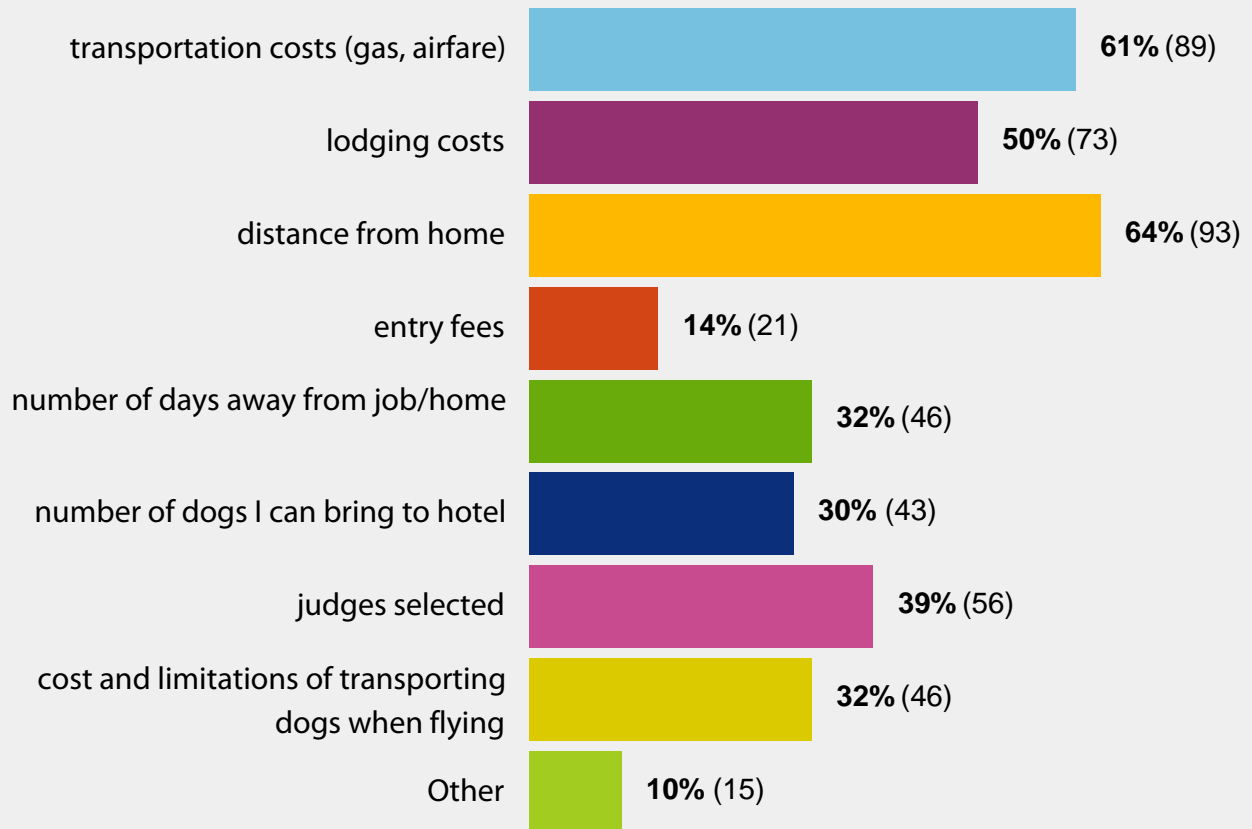


1. What are the main reasons you attend the National Specialty?

What factors influence whether or not you'll attend the Specialty?



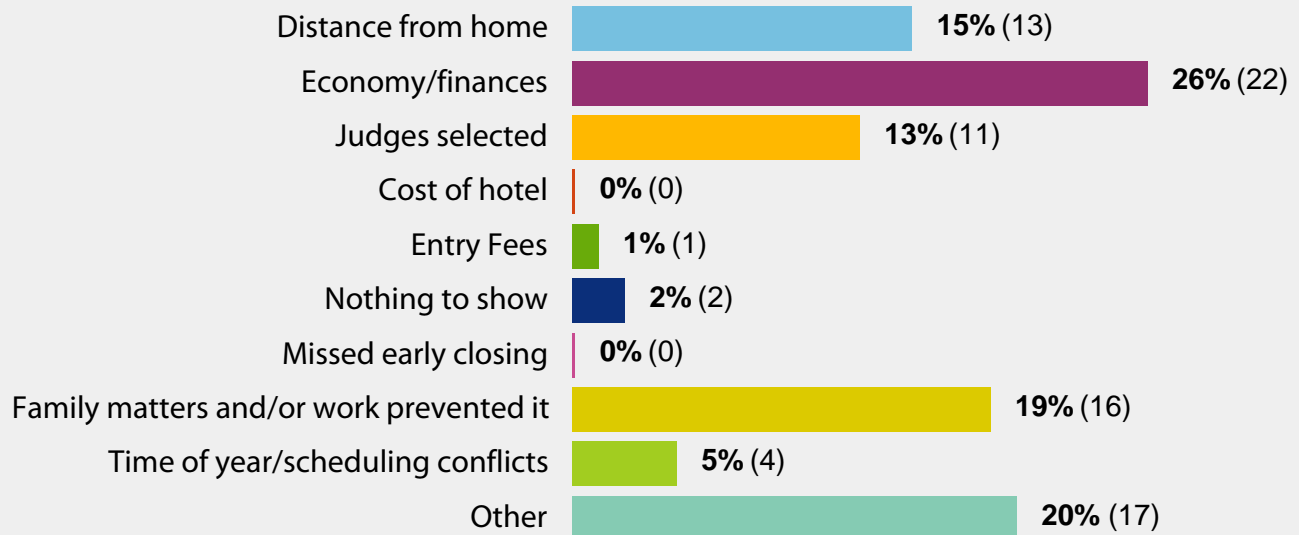

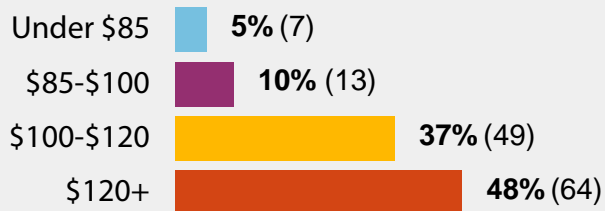

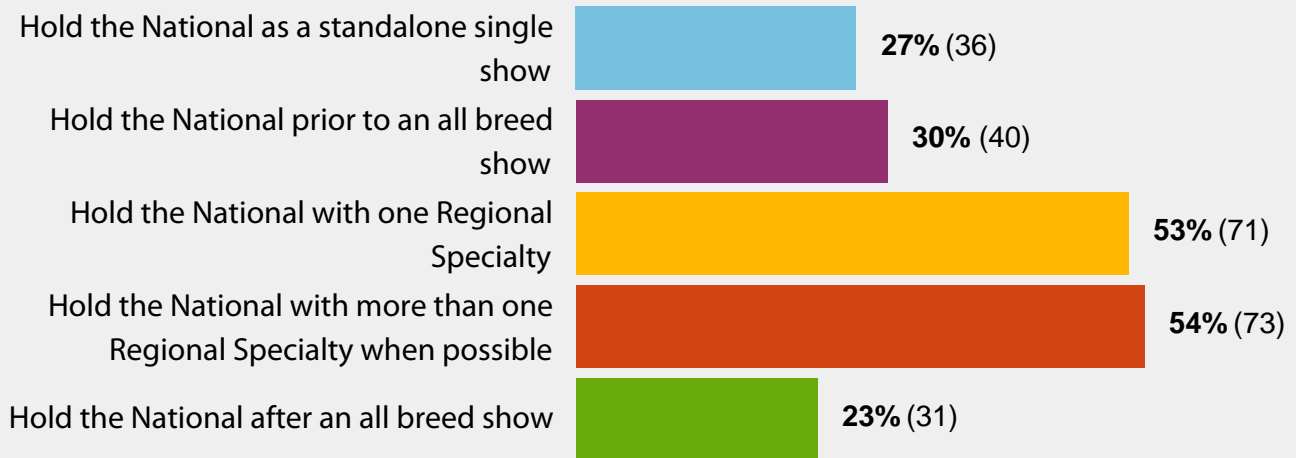

What Price range for hotel rooms blocked for the National would PREVENT you from attending the national or cause you to stay offsite?



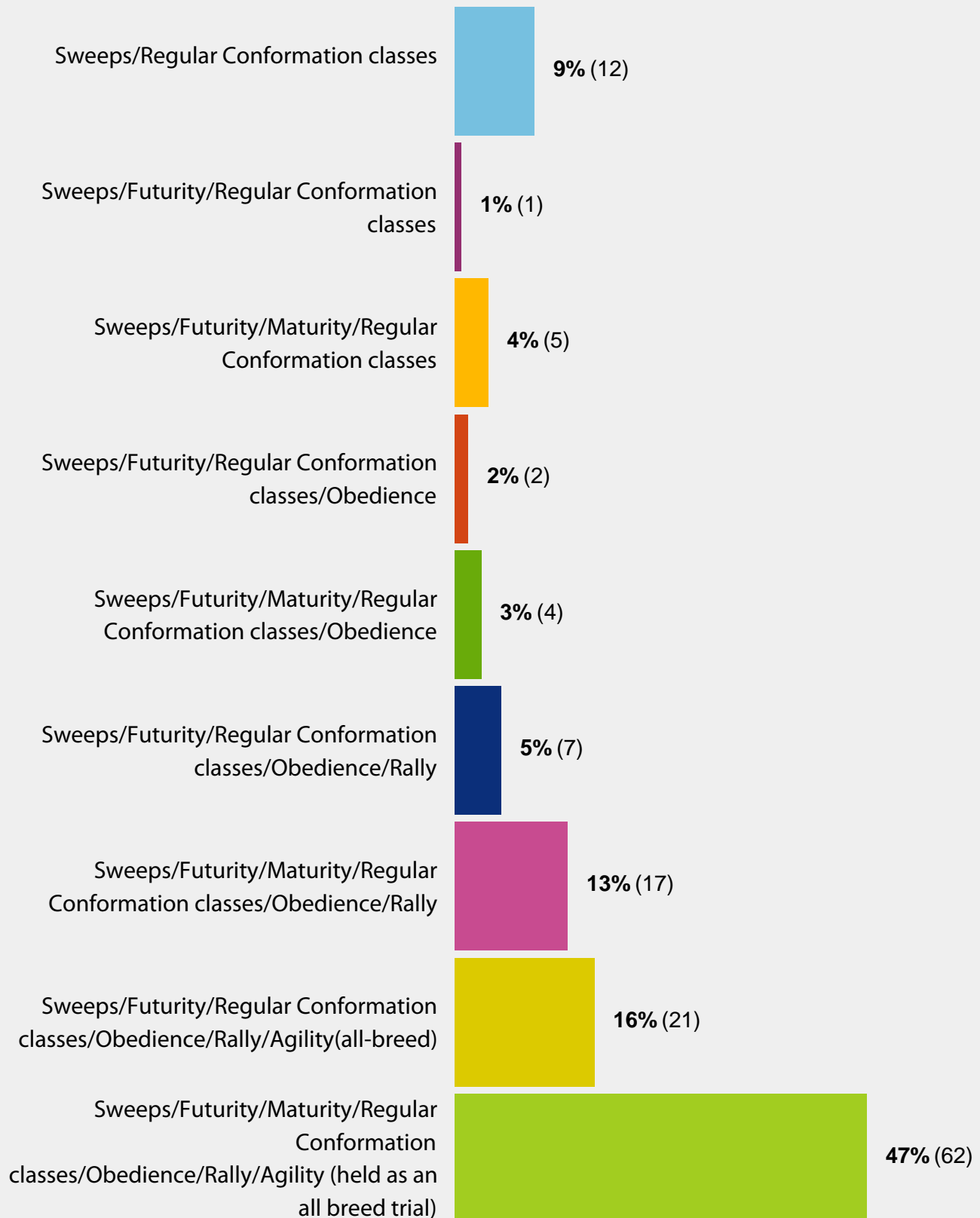

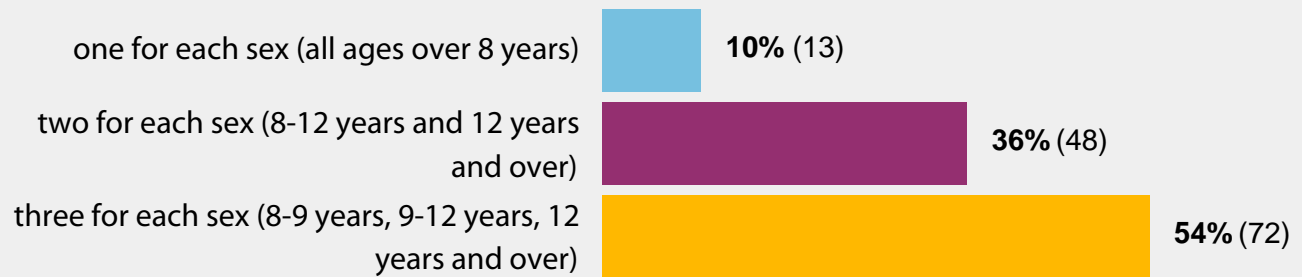

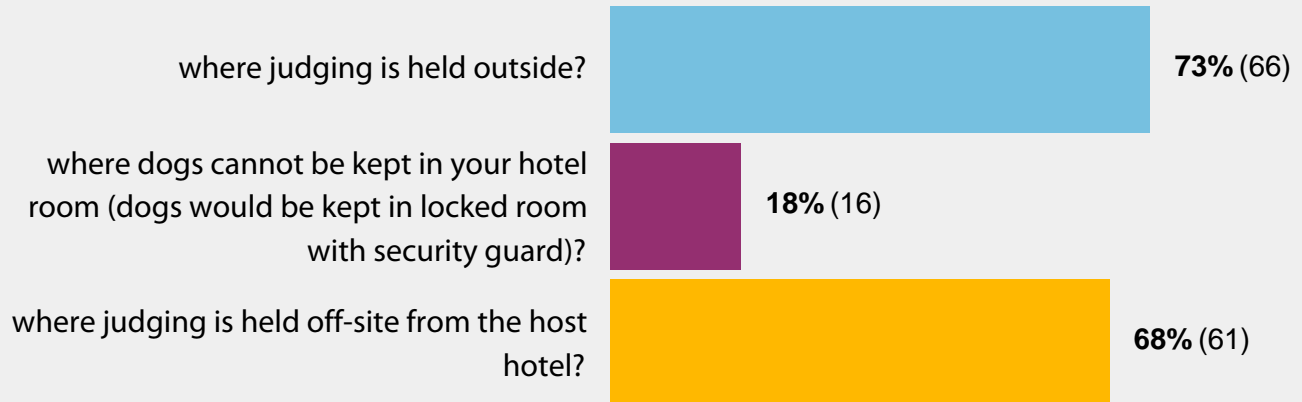

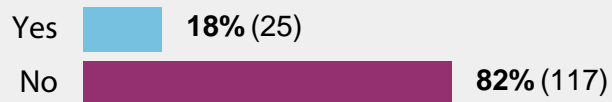

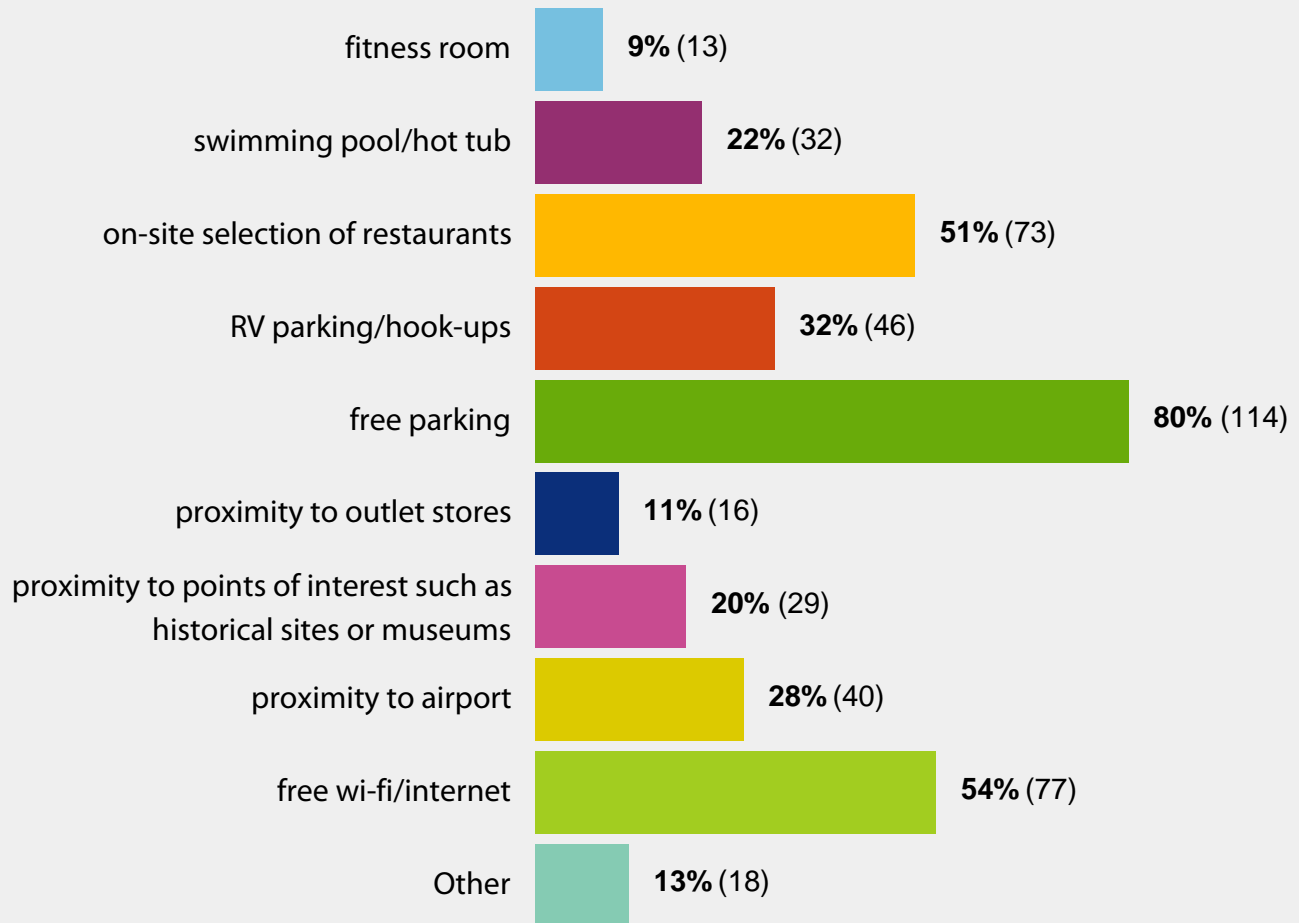

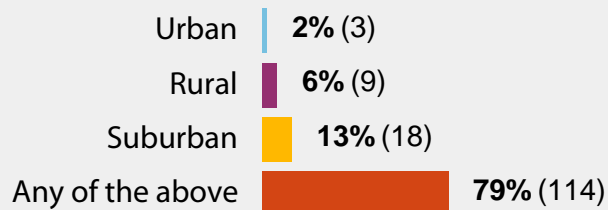
What features are important to you with regards to the hotel?

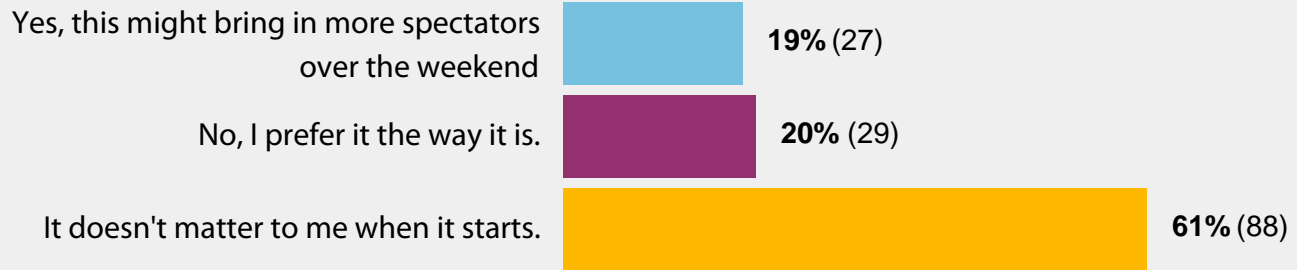

What type of location do you prefer?



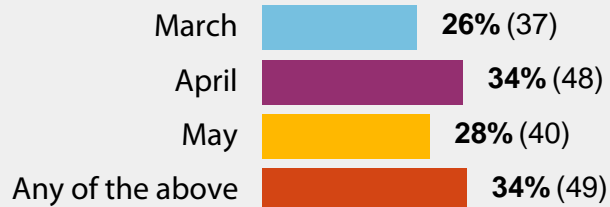

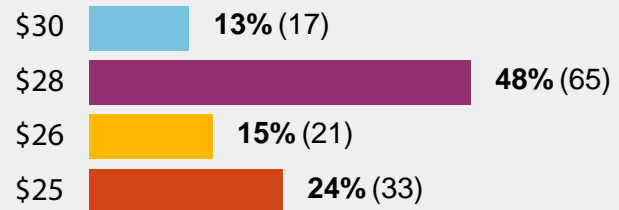

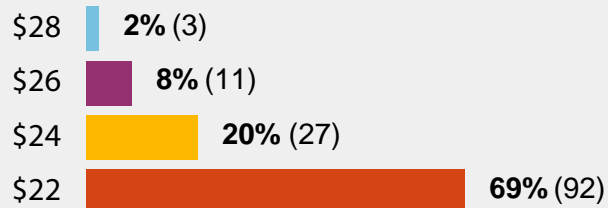

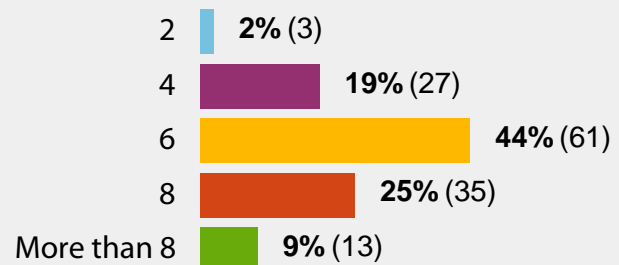

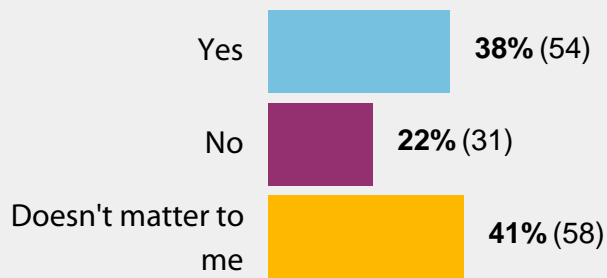

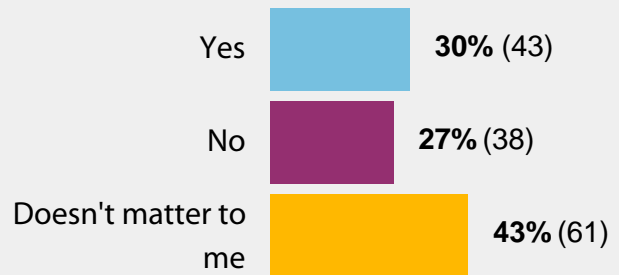

Do you feel the national host hotel should be big enough to host the entire national on site, no matter what the room rate/pet limits are?



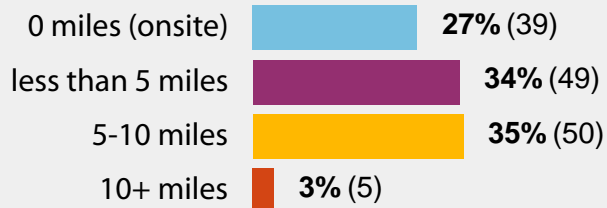

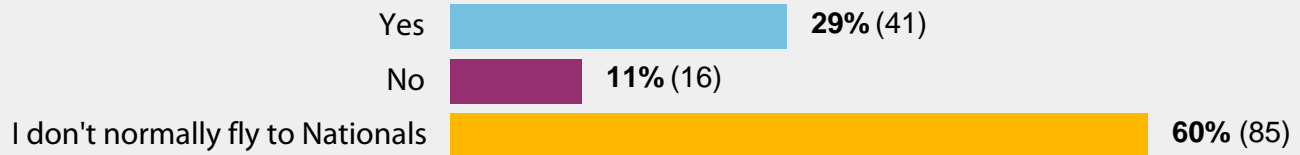

How far from hotel to show site would you consider a reasonable distance for attendees to travel?



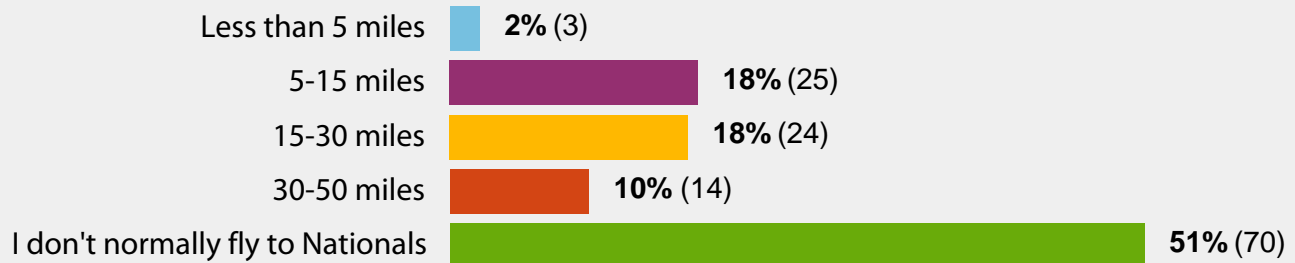

If you travel to the Nationals by plane, do you typically rent a car?



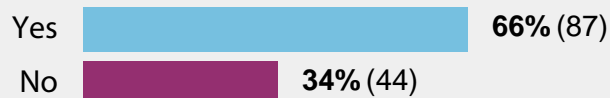

If you travel by plane to the Nationals, how far is reasonable from the closest airport?



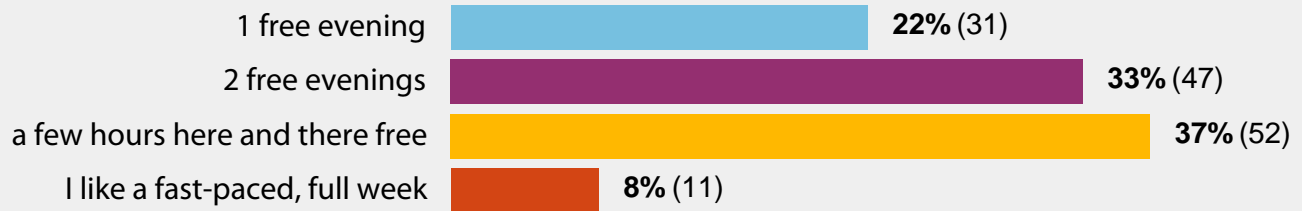

Do you feel that in the past years, ample "free time" is allowed by the show schedule?



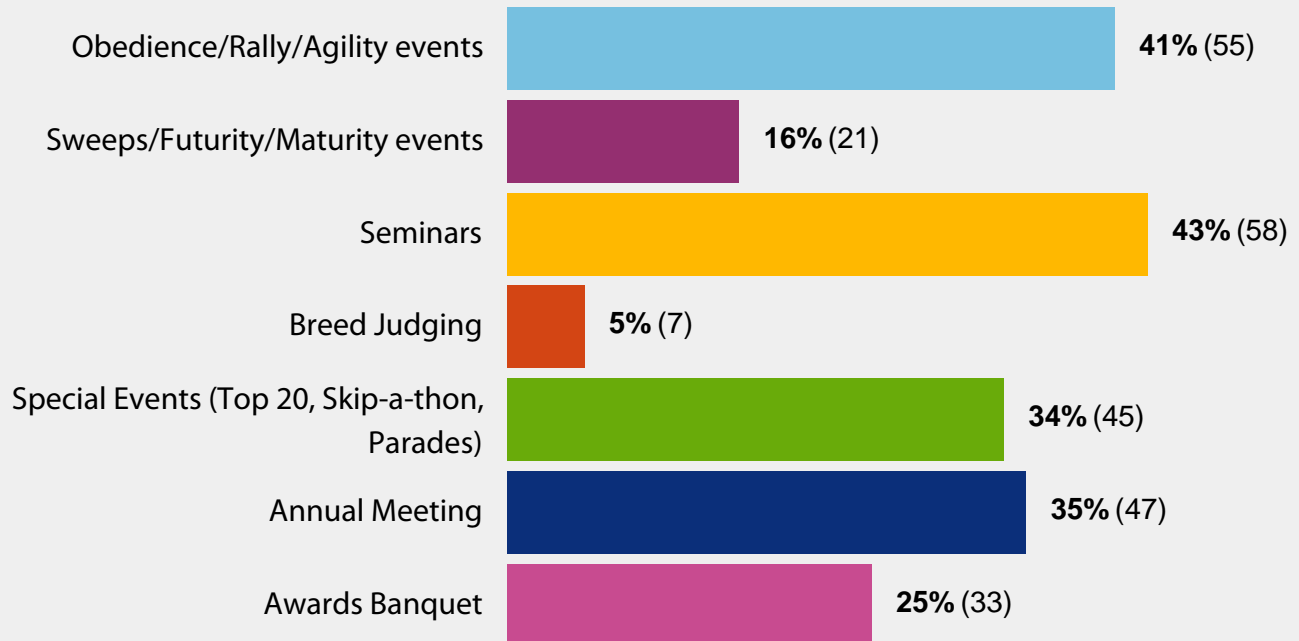

What do you consider ample free time (no scheduled activities) for a Nationals week?



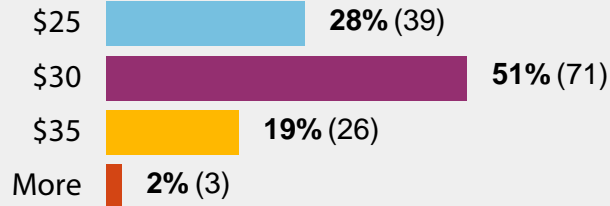

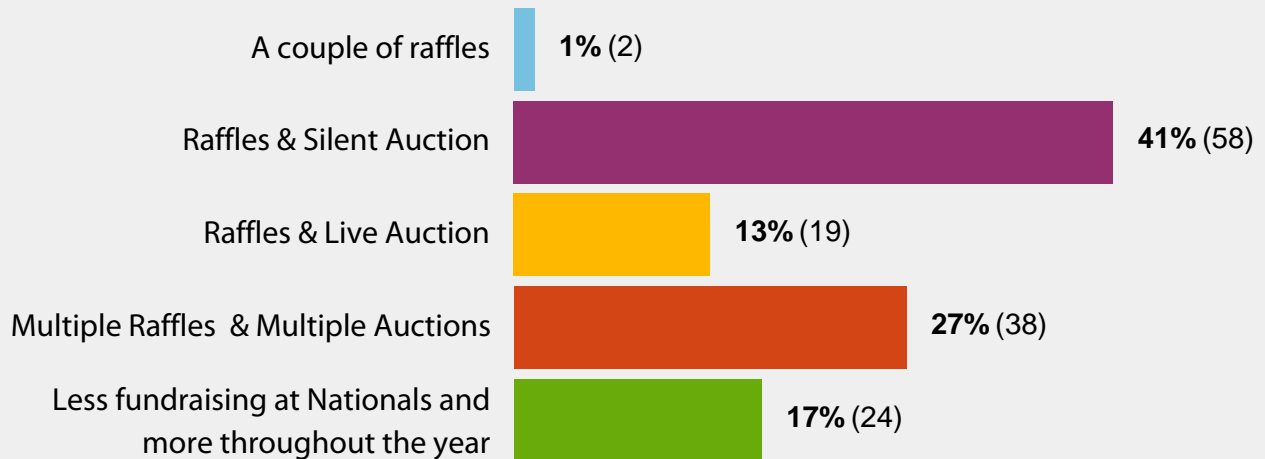

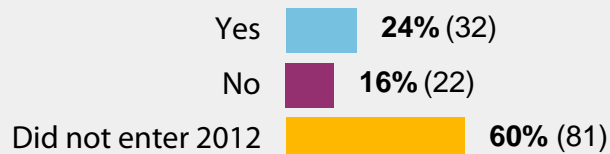

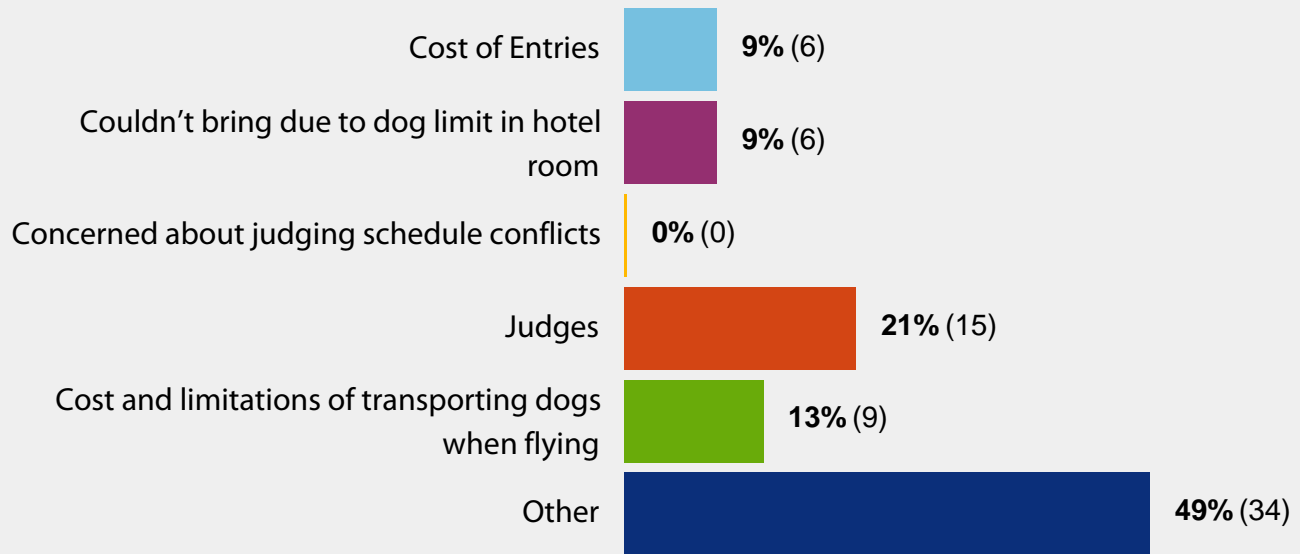

For those that attended 2012 - Did you enter all the dogs you planned/wanted to enter in this year's National?



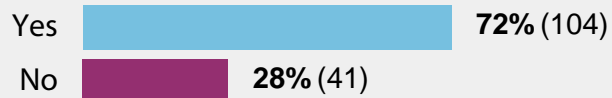
