#### TITLE AWARDS

An Epoxy dome pin with SCA Logo for each dog earning an AKC title. The first pin will be free; however a \$3.00 fee will be required for each subsequent medal for AKC titles earned on the same or additional dogs. Pins for Titles should be applied for, to the Medals Chairman, within 90 days after publication of said title in the AKC AWARDS book.

BEST OF BREED- Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal.

BEST OF OPPOSITE- Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal

WINNERS DOG- Bronze Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal

WINNERS BITCH-Bronze Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal

HIGH IN TRIAL- Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal

## **AREA SPECIALTIES**

Return postcards will be furnished to the show-giving Club to be awarded to the member winners for each class. Winners may receive their award by returning the postcard to the Medals Chairman. Show giving Clubs must request these return cards prior to show date. The show-giving club **must** publish the requirements and prizes in the premium list.

Awards for area specialties are as follows:

# **SPECIAL AWARDS**

## All awards listed below are to be announced and awarded at the Annual Banquet:

- 1. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member owning the Schipperke winning the most points in conformation, based on the Club point system. Said Dog is to be designated as Top Winning Schipperke for the year.
- 2. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member who bred the Top Winning Schipperke for that year.
- 3. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso memorial medal to the member owning the Schipperke of Opposite Sex to the top Winning Schipperke who has accumulated the most points based on the Club point system.

- 4. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member who bred the Top Best of Opposite dog or bitch.
- 5. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to each member owning a Schipperke who has won a Best in Show while under his or her ownership. Each dog is limited to one medal per year.
- 6. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member owning the #1 Dog winning the most points in conformation, based on the Club point system for Breed points.
- 7. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member who bred the #1 Dog for that year based on the Club points system for Breed points.
- 8. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso memorial medal to the member owning the #1 Bitch who has accumulated the most points based on the Club point system for Breed points.
- 9. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member who bred the #1 Bitch based on the Club point system for Breed points.
- 10. If the same dog or bitch wins both categories (breed and all breed points) there will be a limit of one medal for that dog and one medal for that breeder.
- 11. A Plaque, value not to exceed \$50.00, engraved with the dog's name, owner, breeder and year shall be awarded to the member owning the dog having the most BIS wins. In case of a tie, the most number of dogs defeated for BIS wins shall determine the winner.
- 12. The <u>BestJunior.com</u> rosette for the Junior Handler with the most points received for showing a Schipperke during the calendar year. The rosette shall be sent directly to the Best Junior Handler. Their membership status in SCA will be immaterial to this prestigious win.

#### MEMORIAL AWARD

The Schipperke Club of America offers open to all, for First place in the Bred by Exhibitor classes at the National Specialty, a trophy valued at approximately \$25.00 to be designated as the Roy Henre "Jet-O Kennels" Memorial Trophy.

#### PRESIDENT'S PIN

All Presidents of the SCA receive, upon leaving office, a lapel pin to be designated as a Past President Pin, the value of which should not exceed \$20.00. The aforementioned pin is to be presented at the annual Awards Banquet to the outgoing President by the newly elected President if possible. This award is to be an ongoing permanent award.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. A Plaque, value not to exceed \$40.00, shall be awarded to the Highest Scoring Junior Showmanship winner handling a Schipperke. Said Plaque shall be engraved with the Junior Handler's name and the year.
- 2. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal, engraved with name and year, shall be awarded to any Junior Handler who qualifies for Westminster providing all wins for qualification are with a Schipperke.

One point shall be awarded to each Junior Handler for each other handler defeated at an AKC Licensed Member Show.

#### **OBEDIENCE**

1. Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to owner of the Schipperke winning the most points using the SCA point system. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Obedience Schipperke.

- 2. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to member owning a Schipperke who wins an All-Breed High in Trial at an AKC Trial. Said dog must defeat at least 45 other dogs to be eligible. Each dog is limited to one medal per year.
- 3. A Plaque, value not to exceed \$50.00, to be awarded to the member owning the Schipperke with the most all breed HIT wins. In case of a tie, the most number of dogs defeated shall determine the winner.
- 4. A Bronze Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in either Novice A or B. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Novice Obedience Schipperke.
- 5. A Silver Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in either Open A and/or Open B. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Open Obedience Schipperke.
- 6. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in either Utility A and/or Utility B. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Utility Obedience Schipperke.

## **AGILITY and AGILITY PREFERRED**

- 1. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to owner of the Schipperke winning the most points using the SCA point system. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Agility Schipperke.
- 2. A Bronze Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in Novice agility classes. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Novice Agility Schipperke.
- 3. A Silver Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in Open agility classes. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Open Agility Schipperke.
- 4. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points, based on the Club point system, in Excellent agility classes. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Excellent Agility Schipperke.

#### RALLY

- 1. A Sterling Silver Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to owner of the Schipperke winning the most points using the Club point system. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Rally Schipperke.
- 2. A Bronze Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points based on the Club point system, in either Rally Novice A or B. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Rally Novice Schipperke.
- 3. A Silver Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points based on the Club point system in Rally Advanced. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Rally Advanced Schipperke.
- 4. A Gold Plated Ch. Maroufke of Kelso Memorial Medal to the member accumulating the most points based on the Club point system, in Rally Excellent. Said dog is to be designated as Top Winning Rally Excellent Schipperke. Only one medal per dog per year.

## **CERTIFICATES**

A paper Certificate with the dog's name, placement (including ties), breeder, owner and year goes to the **member owning** each of the following:

- Top 10 Conformation Dog (based on AB points)
- Top 10 Conformation Bitch (based on AB points)
- Top 10 Conformation Dogs and Bitches Inclusive (based on AB points)
- Top 10 Conformation Dogs and Bitches Inclusive, Based upon Breed Points Only
- Top Stud Dog
- Top Brood Bitch
- Top 10 Junior Handlers
- Top 10 Obedience Dog Placements
- Top 10 Agility Dog Placements
- Top Ten Preferred Agility Dog Placements
- Top Ten FAST Agility Dog Placements
- Top Ten FAST Preferred Agility Dog Placements
- Top Ten Rally Obedience Dog Placements

Any Schipperke who earns a UD, RAE, MX, MXJ, PAX, MXF, TD, TDX or VST title. (Limited to one certificate per year per dog. The Certificate will indicate all eligible titles obtained in that year.) Note: titles such as RAE, in which there are levels i.e. RAE 1, RAE2 will be recognized at each numerical designation.

**Breeder** of a Best in Show Dog or Bitch.

## SCA POINT SYSTEM - CONFORMATION

One point shall be awarded for each dog defeated at an AKC Licensed or Member Show. One point for each dog defeated in: BIS, Group and BOB are tallied for All-Breed points. One point for each dog defeated for BOB is used for Breed points. AKC Awards is used to verify wins and points.

Note: Per Standing Rule 90-03B: Points accrued for SCA awards by a dog begin with the date the membership application is approved by the Board.

>45 dogs competing in regular classes: 10 points 10 to 45 dogs competing in regular classes: 6 points 5-9 dogs competing in regular classes: 3 points

# SCA POINT SYSTEM - AGILITY and AGILITY PREFERRED

Standard and Jumpers with Weaves points are combined and both use the same point system.
